Project Overview

- Looking forward to partnering with participation with participating LTC facilities and collaboration between MHA and CPS HAI's are an important issue in LTC and hospital arenas.
- 42% of MO nursing homes are cited for infection (F441) vs. 37% nationally
- F441 is the second most frequently cited tag for MO nursing homes
- Evidence shows many CAUTIs and other infections are preventable
- Value-based payment is coming; direct effect on revenue
